NZ Market weekly update

Single BMSB found in Mount Maunganui

A single brown marmorated stink bug (BMSB) has been found in the Mount Maunganui area. The male bug was caught and reported to the MPI hotline and subsequently identified as a BMSB, resulting in MPI carrying out an immediate investigation. The discovery of a single bug does not necessarily mean that other bugs will be found, however MPI surveillance at the property and surrounding area, will establish if there are more bugs present. WorkSafe has been advised of six fatalities on New Zealand farms this month alone. That brings us to a total of 18 farming deaths this year.
